- Provide written reports following Fannie Mae Physical Needs Assessment guidelines, Rural Development Capital Needs Assessment guidelines or other guidelines provided by state agencies providing funding for multifamily rehabilitation projects.
- Attend in-office meetings as required by Project Managers and weekly Conference Call.
- Work with Project Managers to schedule job site visits.
- Have experience working in accessibility codes that apply to multifamily developments including UFAS, Fair Housing, ANSI at community spaces and construction regulations to include observations of noncompliance in reports.
